The HUGH H. MACKAY - JAMES A. MACMURRAY scholarships are open to residents of the Province of New Brunswick who will graduate from high school in May/June of the year of application and who intend to enroll in a New Brunswick or Nova Scotia University in the fall of the same year.

Scholarships will be awarded, each with a minimum value of \$3,500.00 per year for each of the four years of the student's degree programme.

CRITERIA

Each candidate must:

- · be a high school graduate in the year of application;
- · be domiciled in New Brunswick;
- · be an exceptional student;
- · be interested in preparing for a career in business;
- · complete the Official Application Form;
- · submit a letter indicating personal career aspirations. Attached should be lists of activities including summer and part-time work, as well as other extra-curricular activities in which the applicant has been involved:
- ensure the school principal completes and submits the Principal's Confidential Report Form and a copy of high school records to date.
- · begin studies in the Fall of the year of application in a New Brunswick or Nova Scotia University.

PAYMENT

MacMurray Foundation Inc. ("the Foundation") will forward to the business office of the universities chosen by the winners, cheques in the amount of the scholarship, to be credited to the tuition account of each winner. If a balance remains, this will be given to the student early in the second term to assist in meeting other incidental expenses. If a student withdraws at any time during the year, the University involved will return any balance to the Foundation.

Note: No award will be confirmed until the Foundation has received, from the student, a photostatic copy of the OFFICIAL LETTER of Registration from the chosen university. It is not necessary to send the ORIGINAL letter of acceptance.

RENEWALS

Students who receive the Hugh H. Mackay - James A. MacMurray scholarships may, at the end of each undergraduate academic year, apply for renewal of the awards. This will require the submission of a personal letter in which they present progress reports on their studies. They must, in addition, ensure that the Registrar's Office sends to the Secretary of the Mackay - MacMurray Scholarship Fund copies of the official academic transcripts. Satisfactory progress towards the degree will assure renewal. Scholarships may be held for a maximum of 4 years.
