
## **<u>Tiberius</u>** (14-37 AD)

•Lacking in personal relations.


•Lacked ability to convince people of his abilities.






- Army mutinied many times during his reign.
- 56 treason cases murder attempts.
- Retired from Rome near the end of his reign to Isle of Capri.
- He made decisions without consulting the senate.

## <u>Caligula</u> (37-41 AD)





- Presented by Praetorian Guard as next emperor.
- Son of Agrippina -Augustus' granddaughter.
- Reigned for 4 years.
- Aristocratic monarch.



- Wanted to become a god while he was still alive.
- Pardoned all political prisoners
- Spent money on games, festivals
- Wanted to conquer Britain
- He and his family were killed by the Praetorian Guard

## <u>Claudius</u> (41-54 AD)

- Scholar, historian
- Competent, firmminded.
- Consulted senate
- Benevolent dictator
- Did what the people wanted
- He had four wives.






- Fourth wife Agrippina ambitious, self-serving mother of Nero.
- She had Nero marry one of Claudius' daughters.
- She wanted Nero to become emperor so she could rule behind the scenes.



- She tried to affect Claudius' decisions.
- She poisoned him in 54 AD
