Welcome to Fashion Technology 120! The purpose of this program is to extend sewing ability needed to construct intermediate or advanced sewing projects. Students will continue mastering the skills that will allow them to construct and maintain clothing for themselves and their families. Some of these skills for the preparation to sew include: ironing/pressing, taking measurements, textile care, fabric use, pattern alterations, mending, cutting and marking techniques. Other skills for clothing construction include: casing, centered zipper, collar, cuffs, grading, buttonhole, darts, interfacing, pipping, pleats, fasteners, stitching in the ditch, machine hemming, seam finishes, gathering, and hand-stitching.
