

Dear parents and students,

Welcome back to school, from MVHS staff! The English Department would like to take the time to inform you about our library services and policies.

Here at Miramichi Valley High School we are fortunate enough to have a full time librarian, Ms. Jillian Coughlan. This is great news for our

students as they have convenient access to multiple spaces and services our library has to offer.

Library services are available during the day via teacher booking (during class time), and for student convenience, Ms. Coughlan opens the library daily outside of regular class times for students to drop in.

Our library has 2 floors. On the first floor our students have access to 16 computers with internet access, a printer for students to print assignments (there is no cost to print assignments), a wide variety of books and novels to checkout and return, or renew as necessary, as well as 8 large tables for students to have a quiet place to study and work on assignments. The second floor is non-fiction, accompanied by 6 large tables and 2 couches.

As a department, we wanted to highlight the library services as they will play a fundamental role in your English classes. All English classes participate in choice reading and students are responsible to come to class with a book. **Assignments are due at the beginning of class; all assignments must be printed before class.** If you do not have access to a printer at home, please use the library.
