Summer Camp - Students and chaperones will travel from New Brunswick to China, where they will spend time at the Beijing, Anhui, Changsha and Shenzhen Concord Colleges of Sino-Canada.

The College will organize a program consisting of classroom instruction including introductory courses in **Chinese culture**, **language**, **martial arts**, etc. Participants will also visit major cultural and historic sites including the **Great Wall**, **Tiananmen Square**, **and The Forbidden City**.

At the same time, Chinese students will be taking part in an English language program. Activities will be scheduled so that **New Brunswick and Chinese students can join together in activities**, to reinforce skills in both languages.

Application Process

- Complete application form and submit an essay about yourself and why you should be chosen.
- Recommendation from school principal.
- Application needs to be submitted by Dec. 11, 2015*.
- If selected, a \$500 deposit is required by Jan. 29, 2016; \$250 is non-refundable.
- Applicants must be over 15 years of age as of June 30, 2016.

All participants, will receive a \$1000 bursary which will be applied towards the airfare.

Students must complete an essay detailing their experiences upon return. A \$500 prize will be awarded to the top essay.

* Late applicants will be considered if spaces have not been filled.

Summer Camp China

Summer Camp Details:

- * Accommodations; student dormitories on campus (accommodations are similar to university dormitories in Canada)
- * 2-4 New Brunswick and Chinese students per room
- * Washroom and shower facilities on each floor/wing of the dormitory
- * Female and male dormitories are separate
- * Each dormitory is chaperoned by a Chinese teacher/worker (dormitory rules are mandatory & NB chaperones are close by)
- * Provided meals; typical cafeteria-style Chinese food, with some opportunity to experience meals in Chinese restaurants
- All in country transportation provided
- During the first weekend, the New Brunswick students will be hosted by a Chinese family in their home

Orientation Session will be

held prior to departure in early June. It is expected that all participants and their parents/guardians, attend these sessions. Important information will be distributed, as well as the opportunity to meet other participants and chaperones.
