

## Science 10 Final Exam Review

The following is the review for your final exam. I highly suggest covering all aspects of this review as it will be extremely useful in preparing for your final exam.

When reviewing for your exam you should do the following:

- Look over all of your old tests
  - I would highly suggest redoing your tests – if you don't do anything else with studying then you should **definitely** redo your tests!
- Read over your notes
  - If you are an auditory learner then read your notes aloud or have someone read them to you. This should be done several times, not just once!
  - If you are more of a visual learner then re-copy your notes – yes this is a lot of work but it is work that will pay off if you put the effort into it.
- Look at the sections that we covered in your textbook
  - Look through these sections and pull out **bolded words** and make sure you know what they mean.

Textbook sections covered in each unit are as follows:

**Chemistry Unit:** 1.1, 1.2, 1.7, 2.1, 2.5 (Lab), 2.8, 2.10, 2.12, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, 3.6, 4.1, 4.3, and 4.4 (Science 9)

**Chemistry Unit:** 5.1, 5.5, 5.6, 5.8, 5.9, 5.11, 6.1, 6.3, 6.5, 6.6, 6.7, 6.10, 7.3, 8.2, 8.3 and 8.10 (Science 10)

**Physics Unit:** 9.4, 9.5, 9.7, 10.2, 10.3, 10.4, 10.7, 11.1, 11.3, 11.7, 12.1, 12.2, 12.5, and 12.6 (Science 10)

**Electricity Unit:** 9.1, 9.2, 9.3, 9.5, 9.8, 10.3 & 10.10 (Science 9)

The exam consists of 50 Multiple Choice Questions and 17 Short Answer Questions. You will need the following during the exam:

- Pencils for Scantron Sheet
- Pens
- Eraser
- CALCULATOR
- Knowledge
- **Periodic Table**
- Lucky charm (if necessary)
