



ALCOOL NB LIQUOR FIRST NATIONS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM – 2012

Sponsor

The Board of Directors of Alcool NB Liquor seeks to support First Nations students enrolled in a program to obtain their first post-secondary accreditation. The purpose of the Scholarship Program is to provide financial support and an incentive for First Nations students.

Application Deadline

Deadline June 15, 2012

Value of the Award

There will be four awards of \$1,250.00 each per year.

Number of Awards

Two First Nation students from Miramichi Valley High School and Two First Nation students from NSER High School.

Application Requirement/Description

Only First Nation students attending MVHS or NSER are eligible to apply. All applicants must be planning to attend a full-time post-secondary accredited college, university, or trade/technical school in a program with duration of at least one school year. The selection committee will evaluate the application on the basis of the criteria stated below and their decision will be final.

Selection

The selection committee will evaluate applications on the basis of the following criteria and the decision is final:

- ❖ Participation – The amount of participation in school, sports, part-time work, and community life outside of class requirements.
- ❖ Presentation – Selection will be considered on the written presentation.
- ❖ With respect to academic standing, applicants must identify an established ability to commit appropriate effort and diligence toward their scholastic endeavours.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM – 2012 (Cont'd)

Applicants must submit all of the following documents

- ❖ A short written presentation which: 1) introduces the applicant, 2) describes why they have chosen the particular field of study, 3) lists their volunteer, community, school, university activities and why they participate in them, 4) describes any part-time work experience, and 5) explains why they deserve the award.
- ❖ One reference letter – from either the school that is currently being attended or from a sport affiliation, volunteer/non profit organization or place of work.
- ❖ Transcripts – Grade 11 marks plus first semester Grade 12 marks if you are a Grade 12 student. Otherwise, Grade 11 and Grade 12 marks plus transcripts to date for the year/years you have spent in a post-secondary institution.
- ❖ Fully completed and signed Application Form.
- ❖ Failure to provide all of the above documents may result in the application not being considered.
