

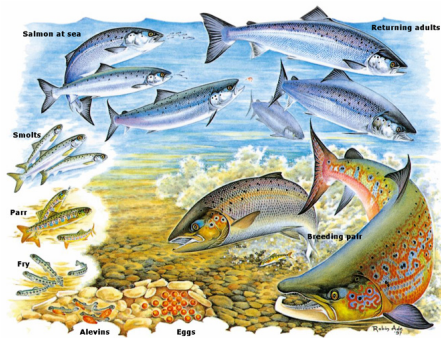

# Safety Protocols...starting Semester 2

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1) All school doors will be locked during the school day from 8:30 AM to 3:20 PM, with the exception of lunch time (11:45 AM to 12:40 PM) where the main doors, gym doors and bus loading doors at the back of the school will be open. The main entrance of the school is now equipped with a live video feed and buzzer system located on the brick wall left of the main front doors. Upon arrival, please press the button for entry and report to the main office. Students are reminded that if they are leaving during the day for an appointment, they must sign out at the main office and exit through the main doors. Students will be required to provide an excuse upon their return when they sign in. Anyone requiring services in any of our Industrial areas are required to report to the main office before proceeding to the shop area. **AT NO TIME ARE STUDENTS TO EVER OPEN A LOCKED DOOR TO ALLOW OTHERS TO ENTER. THIS WILL BE VIEWED AS NON COMPLIANCE AND A DIRECT VIOLATION OF SCHOOL RULES.**

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2) All visitors to our school will be required to sign in at the office and pick up a Visitor Pass. Visitors Passes are to be returned to the office when signing out. *This will not apply during arrival and dismissal times.*

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3) All replacement staff will now be identified with a Staff Lanyard.

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4) Students will be required to have a hall pass from their subject teacher when out of class during Instructional Time.

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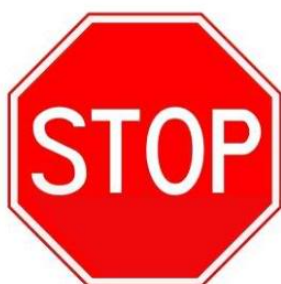

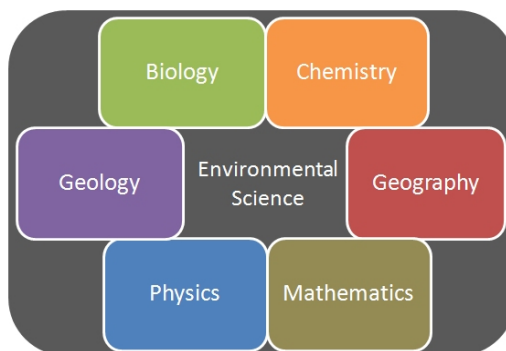
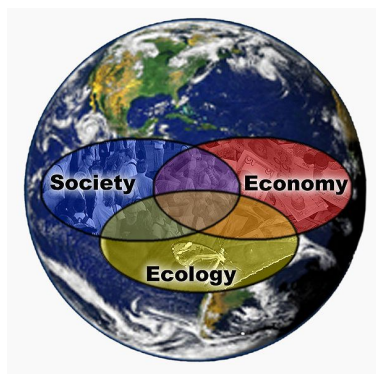


# What is Environmental Science?

## ANGLOPHONE NORTH SCHOOL DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL ATTENDANCE PROTOCOL

In accordance with the **Education Act**, the following are guidelines for specific school actions after a number of absences in a subject.

1. **5 absences** - Teacher contact with home (time of call, person contacted) (**Appendix A**).
  - Form goes to administration after contact is made.
  
2. **12 absences**- Subject teacher to forward student's name to school administration. Administration, with the support of EST-G, EST-R and other relevant staff, will meet with student and parent/guardian to create an action-plan with the student for attendance improvement depending on individual circumstances/time of year (**Appendix B and Attachment to Appendix B**).
  - A copy of **Appendix B** and **Appendix C** will be provided to the parent/guardian.
  
3. **18 absences**- Guidance will meet with the student to review the Attendance Improvement Plan and make recommendations to administration (**Appendix D**).
  
4. **20 absences**- If the student continues to be absent after all appropriate interventions have been attempted, this student is, in effect, non-compliant with school rules. It is at the discretion of the Principal to explore further disciplinary action.

These timelines are not intended to take away from the **discretion** of the school when it is felt there is still hope that a student may be successful.
