TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The scholarship is open to students from Douglastown service area.
- 2. The scholarship is a one-time award of \$1000.00.
- 3. The award will be paid to successful applicant in two \$500.00 installments, September and January upon verification from the education institution that they have commenced a program of at least two (2) years.
- 4. Selection will be based on financial need and character.
- 5. A committee struck from the Douglastown Lions Club will select the award winner.
- 6. All information supplied by the applicants is confidential.
- 7. Applications must be received no later then May 31st.
- 8. Applicants must be a Grade 12 graduate of the current year.
- 9. All applicants must show that they have contributed something to their school by participating in some club, group or team while they were attending high school.
- 10. All decisions of the committee shall be final.
