# AREA Formulas...



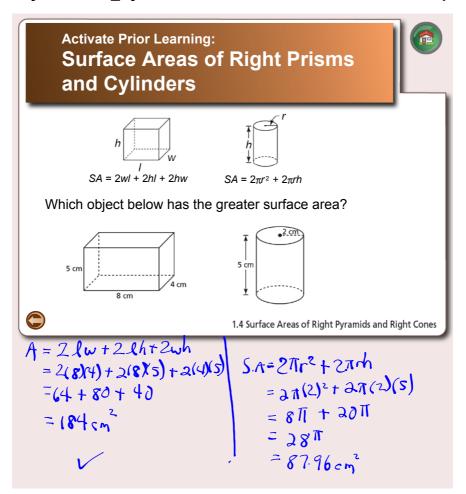


## **Surface Area**

Surface area is the total area of all of the faces of the object.

## **Steps need to find Surface area are:**

- 1. Draw all of the faces with dimensions displayed on them.
- 2. Find the area of each face.
- 3. Then add up the areas of all of the faces.



The surface area of a prism is equal to the sum of the areas of its faces. For a rectangular prism with length  $\ell$ , width w, and height h, the surface area is  $S = 2\ell w + 2\ell h + 2wh$ .

**EXAMPLE (1)** Find the surface area of the rectangular prism.

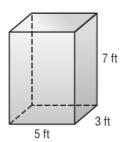
$$\begin{split} S &= 2\ell w + 2\ell h + 2wh \\ S &= 2(3)(5) + 2(3)(7) + 2(5)(7) \end{split}$$

Surface area of a prism 
$$\ell=3, w=5, h=7$$
  
Simplify.

S = 142

The surface area is 142 squar

he surface area C of a cylinde





$$A = 2 l \omega + 2 l h + 2 \omega h$$
  
=  $2(3(5) + 2(3(7)) + 2(5(7))$   
=  $30 + 42 + 70$   
=  $142 + 17$ 

The surface area S of a cylinder with height h and radius r is the area of the two bases plus the area of the curved surface, or  $S = 2\pi r^2 + 2\pi rh$ .

### EXAMPLE 2

Find the surface area of the cylinder. Round to the nearest tenth.

$$S = 2\pi r^2 + 2\pi rh$$
  
 
$$S = 2\pi (5)^2 + 2\pi (5)(9)$$

Surface area of a cylinder r = 5, h = 9

 $S \approx 439.8$ 

Simplify.

The surface area is about 439

SOLUTION

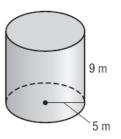
$$A = 2\pi r^2 + 2\pi rh$$

$$= 2\pi (s)^2 + 2\pi (s)(9)$$

$$= 507 + 907$$

$$= 1407$$

$$= 439.82 m^2$$

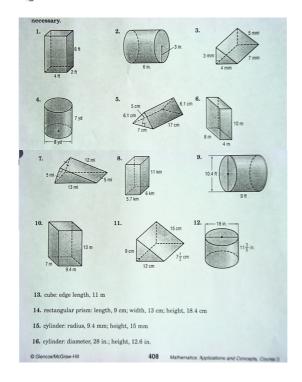
