
7.2 - Pairs of Angles Notes on Naming

Pairs of Angles

When naming angles use $\underline{\text{three letters}}$.

In the example, C is the point not the angle. That angle would be ∠ACB where the middle letter C is the location of the angle. (∠BCA is the same angle)
