ELIGIBILITY

If integrity, determination and courage describe you - you have what it takes to be a Horatio Alger Scholar. Our scholarships reward students who possess the character to overcome adversity and succeed in life. We help students overcome financial barriers to pursue higher education.

To be considered eligible for the Horatio Alger Canadian Scholarship Program, applicants must:

- Be graduating high school or CEGEP with plans to pursue a university education in the fall
- Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree program
- Demonstrate critical financial need (annual net family income of \$65,000 or less)
- Be involved in co-curricular and community activities
- Display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Maintain a minimum grade percentage of 65
- Attend high school (or CEGEP) and reside in Canada
- Be a Canadian citizen

The Horatio Alger Association of Canada seeks to assist students who have demonstrated integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, strength of character, financial need, a good academic record, commitment to pursue a post-secondary education, and a desire to contribute to society.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for the Horatio Alger Association of Canada Scholarship Programs, applicants must:

- Be graduating high school or in the final year of CEGEP with plans to enter university in the fall of 2021
- Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree at an accredited university
- Demonstrate critical financial need (\$65,000 or less net income per family is required)
- Be involved in extracurricular and community activities
- Display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Maintain a minimum grade percentage of 65
- Attend high school and reside in Canada
- Be Canadian citizens

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

To apply for the Horatio Alger Association of Canada Scholarship Programs the following items must be completed by **October 25, 2020**:

- An online application at <https://www.horatioalger.ca/en/scholarships>
- One Support Form completed online. This must be completed by an adult over the age of 21 who is not related to the applicant and who is aware of the adversities mentioned in the application. **This form must be filled out online. Faxes, emails, or letters will not be accepted.**
- Online Certification Form. A login will be emailed to the applicant's counsellor. (Please notify your counsellor that they will receive an email from the Association providing instructions for how to complete the certification form online).
- High school (or CEGEP, if applicable) transcript with legend and terminal year courses. Applicants should upload a transcript through the online application.
NOTE: Transcripts must show grades from all years of high school and must be submitted online.
- Income Verification. **A copy of your parent(s) 2019 Annual Tax Return.** Applicants must submit their parent(s) 2019 Annual Tax Return. If your parent(s) have not received a Goods and Services Tax/Harmonized Sale Tax Credit or Notice of Assessment from Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) for 2019 because they did not file their 2019 Income and Benefit Return (T1), include statement copies showing the amount of any government benefit (Disability Support, Social Assistance, or Employment Insurances) received throughout the whole year. **Faxes/emails will not be accepted.**
