ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Douglastown Lions Club Scholarship consists of one (1) scholarship with a value of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) to be awarded to a deserving graduate from the Douglastown service area. (applicants must live between French Fort Cove & Bartibogue)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

1. The scholarship is open to students from Douglastown service area.
2. The scholarship is a one-time award of \$1000.00.
3. The award will be paid to successful applicant in two \$500.00 installments, September and January upon verification from the education institution that they have commenced a program of at least two (2) years.
4. Selection will be based on financial need and character.
5. A committee struck from the Douglastown Lions Club will select the award winner.
6. All information supplied by the applicants is confidential.
7. Applications must be received no later then May 15th.
8. Applicants must be a Grade 12 graduate of the current year.
9. All applicants must show that they have contributed something to their school by participating in some club, group or team while they were attending high school.
10. All decisions of the committee shall be final.
