The applicants are asked to submit an essay (between 500 and 1,250 words) that shows their leadership and/or initiative, including (but not limited to) school, extracurricular activities, and the community

A total of **three** Beaverbrook Scholar Awards  
valued at **\$50,000** each  
(\$12,500 per year for 4 years)  
will be awarded.

**NOTE:** A 3.7 scholarship GPA is required each year to renew this scholarship. Students applying to UNBF under the Grade 11 Science Pilot Program are eligible to apply for this award.

**DEADLINE:** Applications must be received by **March 1**. If the deadline falls on a Saturday or Sunday, please ensure your application package is received by UNB on or before the Friday prior to March 1. The Beaverbrook Selection Committee will review and select the recipients. The Committee is comprised of former Lord Beaverbrook Scholarship recipients as well as former Beaverbrook Scholars Award recipients. The completed application package may be emailed to the Undergraduate Awards Office as a single PDF, faxed or mailed with the required signatures. The applicant must be able to supply the original documentation to the Undergraduate Awards Office upon request.
