2. Sunday, June 18th, 2.00 pm-St. Mary's BACCALAUREATE

EVERYONE IS WELCOME TO ATTEND!

Once again, a Baccalaureate Service is being organized at St. Mary's church. An invitation is extended to all graduates and parents/guardians. Graduates expecting to attend the service are to take note of the following:

- a) The graduates are to assemble in St. Mary's basement at 1:30 pm (the service begins at 2:00 p.m.).
- b) All graduates attending are to wear sashes and gowns for the service.

Refreshments will be served in the church basement after the service. Students with last name beginning with A-L are asked to contribute sandwiches and students with last name beginning with M-Z are asked to bring sweets. Please have refreshments brought in before 1:30 pm. Please write "Baccalaureate" on the container. All food must be nut free.



3. Monday, June 19th, 8:00 pm - 11:00 pm MVHS CAFETERIA - PROM

The prom will be held from 8:00 pm to 11:00 pm in the school cafeteria.

4. Wednesday, June 21st, 9:00 am at Civic Centre GRADUATION CEREMONY REHEARSAL

Attendance is mandatory for the graduation exercises rehearsal. If you do not attend the practice, it will be assumed that you do not intend to participate in the graduation exercises that evening! The practice is necessary so that the graduates will know their positions during the graduation march and ceremony. Please be on time.

5. Wednesday, June 21st, 7:00 pm - Civic Centre GRADUATION CEREMONY

The graduation ceremony for the Class of 2023 will begin at 7:00 pm. Graduates are asked to be at the Lindon Rec Centre 45 minutes early. Each graduate will receive 2 invitations (the 2 invitations are souvenirs and are NOT needed at the graduation). They will also receive 5 "Graduate Guest" tickets, which guests must bring to the ceremony; the ticket enables the holder to be seated on the main floor of the rink (1 ticket per person). Any additional guests will sit on the sides. The seating is based on a first come, first served basis.

Parents and relatives - PLEASE NOTE: WE ASK THAT PARENTS/GUARDIANS NOT TAKE PICTURES IN FRONT OF THE STAGE. A photographer will be taking free colour photographs of each graduate receiving his/her diploma. Again, your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
